

MultiPlan | Priority Medicare benefit brief

Short description	Travel pass for health care coverage outside the lower peninsula of Michigan
Vendor	MultiPlan®
Summary	All Priority Health MAPD (and EGWP plans that choose to add this benefit) will continue to include the Priority Health Travel Pass, giving members the ability to receive all plan-covered services at in-network cost sharing from MultiPlan-contracted providers throughout the U.S. and its territories when members are outside the lower peninsula of Michigan. Members can be out of the service area for up to 12 months and remain enrolled in their Priority Health Medicare plan if they permanently reside in our service area (all 68 counties in the lower peninsula of Michigan).
Where services may be performed	Anywhere in the U.S. and its territories when members are outside the lower peninsula of Michigan.
Authorization required?	No.
Accessing and using the benefit	For out-of-area services, members can visit prioritymedicare.com to find providers who accept either Priority Health or MultiPlan coverage in the area they're visiting. We also recommend members contact our customer service department if they are traveling for long periods of time so our team can help them find providers and arrange services.
Coverage criteria	All Priority Health individual MAPD members and EGWP plans that choose this benefit have coverage through the MultiPlan network. MultiPlan is not available for D-SNP.
