

Infertility Coverage: what to know

Your Priority Health medical plan through the Federal Employee Health Benefits (FEHB) includes coverage for diagnostic, counseling, planning services, prescription drugs, assisted reproduction, and artificial conception related to the treatment of the underlying cause of infertility at 50% coinsurance after deductible. This means that after you pay your deductible, you'd be responsible for 50% of the remaining costs and Priority Health would cover the other 50%.

Examples of covered services include:

- Endometrial biopsy
- Diagnostic laparoscopy or hysteroscopy
- Hormone evaluation
- Semen analysis
- Sperm count
- Egg freezing, thawing, and storage
- Sperm freezing, thawing, and storage
- In vitro fertilization (IVF)
- Artificial insemination (AI)
- Services associated with the treatment and underlying conditions of assisted reproduction and artificial conception such as ultrasounds and imaging

Definition of infertility: the inability to conceive a successful pregnancy after 12 months of egg-sperm contact if the individual is under the age of 35 or after 6 months if the individual is age 35 and older. *Infertility diagnosis may also be based on the individual having a medical or other recognized condition as a cause of infertility.*
