


# Priority Health's 2024 narrow networks

We offer plans to individuals and families under age 65 who purchase their own health coverage. Included in these plan offerings are our four narrow network plans, which offer members care with a specific network of doctors and hospitals at a lower cost.

Here are the Michigan counties where individual plans are available in 2024, including areas with narrow networks:



**Please refer patients to providers within their network. Use Find a Doctor (in the Resources drop-down in prism) to see which providers are in your patient's network. Request authorization for instances where services are not available within their network.**

You can tell a patient is a Priority Health narrow network member one of two ways:

1. Use the Member Inquiry tool in prism. The name of the narrow network will appear in the "Product Type" field.
2. Check your patient's member ID card. The name of the narrow network will be listed as the **Health plan** (see sample member ID card on the back).

Members in these counties are now eligible for the Southeast Michigan Network, which includes Trinity facilities and providers along with Corewell Health facilities and providers in Southeast Michigan.

\*The Ascension St. John Providence Network plan will no longer be offered in 2024. All members who were part of the Ascension network plan who renew their coverage will be transitioned to the Southeast Michigan Network for 2024. However, if these members choose, they can switch to one of Priority Health's broad HMO network plans to maintain coverage for Ascension providers.

# New in 2024: The Southeast Michigan Network


This is a new narrow network product in 2024 that includes former Beaumont Health facilities and providers (now Corewell Health) along with Trinity Health facilities and providers.

Providers are in the Southeast Michigan Network if:

- Provider was part of the former Beaumont Health Network

**OR**

- Provider is part of the Trinity Health East Network



All eligible members will live in Macomb, Oakland or Wayne County. Providers do not need to be located in these three counties to be included in the Southeast Michigan Network.

Members in these counties who in 2023 were part of either the Beaumont Health Network, the Trinity Health East Network or the Ascension St. John Providence Network (plan discontinued) will be transitioned into the Southeast Michigan Network. If members who had the Ascension St. John Providence Network plan in 2023 want to remain in a plan that covers Ascension providers, they can choose a broad HMO network option.

Note that members with the Trinity Health East Network plan who live in Livingston, Washtenaw or Jackson County will continue to be eligible for the same narrow network in 2024, with no changes.

*Note that Priority Health member ID cards never list a member's PCP. While we encourage all members to select a PCP, participating providers can still see patients even if the patient has not chosen a PCP.*
