We're correcting an issue with CPT code 0523T which was requiring a prior authorization in error. This code is not separately payable from the primary procedure for all products. | Read More

New process for submitting Part D immunizations for PriorityMedicare members

Effective Jan. 1, 2026, providers must bill Part D immunizations for PriorityMedicare Dual Premier (HIDE-SNP) members through TransactRx when vaccines are administered in a physician's office. Claims submitted directly to us will deny as provider liability, and providers may not bill members for any vaccine costs or administration fees. The TransactRx process is available for all PriorityMedicare members. | Read More

Effective Mar. 1, 2026, Tysabri will be removed from medical drug coverage, while its generic, tykuro, will be added to medical drug coverage for our commercial group and individual members.

Revlimid®

Effective Feb. 1, 2026, Revlimid will be removed from pharmacy benefit coverage for our commercial group and individual members and from our SaveOnSP drug list for members who participate in this program. | Read More

Providers play an integral role in the care teams that support our dualeligible special needs (D-SNP) members. That's why the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) requires us to make sure providers who are contracted with us to see PriorityMedicare patients are trained on our Model of Care (MOC) every year. Reminder: Physician signatures required on Medicaid Children's Special Health Care Services documentation

Priority Health Medicaid members under the age of 26 may be eligible for coverage through the Michigan Children's Special Health Care Services (CSHCS) program. To support eligibility determinations, MDHHS requires timely documentation of the member's diagnosis and treatment plan. If Priority Health requests this documentation from you on behalf of a Medicaid member, please be sure it is signed by a licensed physician (MD or DO) when you submit it. | Read More
