



Three ways to pay your monthly premium

Paying on time is important, so we've made it easy for you.

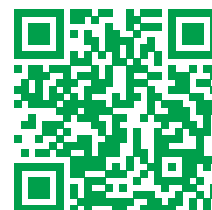
Your premium is the amount you pay each month for your health care coverage.

It's important to pay your premium on time because missing payments could result in your policy being canceled. And, if your policy is canceled due to nonpayment, you may not be eligible to enroll in health coverage again until the next annual Open Enrollment Period (OEP).

There are three easy ways to make your payment:

- 1 Online:** Use your credit card, debit card or electronic funds transfer (EFT) to set up recurring payments or make a one-time payment online. You can manage or change your payment selections by logging in to your member account at member.priorityhealth.com. Setting up recurring payments is one of the easiest ways to make sure your payment is made on time.
- 2 By mail:** Mail your payment coupon and a check to:
